The Canary Islands have a benign climate, enjoying so called eternal spring (with average annual temperatures ranging from 18 to 25 degrees centigrade) and a range of natural attractions: five of its eight islands are a Biosphere Reserve, and the archipelago has four national parks as well.



THE SOUTH OF THE ISLAND

The South of the Island is famous for its tourist attraction of the Dunes of Maspalomas, the kilometers of golden sandy beaches where a a great variety of nautical sports can be practiced. The beaches are the following ones: Arguineguín-Patalavaca, Anfi del Mar, Puerto Rico, Amadores, Tauro, Playa del Cura, Taurito and the Puerto de Mogán (the Mogán Harbour).



LAS PALMAS DE GRAN CANARIA

Las Palmas de Gran Canaria is the capital city of the Canaries. It has mild climate thanks to its location, and to the trade winds coming from northwest Atlantic. The result is an average temperature of 17°C in winter and 25°C in summer seasons. It is in the top 10 of the largest cities in Spain.
